Equities Bounce Back on Lyons Range

Equity prices bounced back on the local share market today recording handsome gains on unabated support from financial institutions, announcement of the new export policy by the BJP government and persistent inquiries. The operators conveniently ignored the discouraging advices from upcountry exchanges. Thanks to the large scale support, the unnerving bear hammering and unabated long liquidation, which had gripped the market during the few days, seemed to have been effectively arrested.

Tata Motors recovered from Rs. 425 to 448 on heavy institutional support before finishing at Rs 440 gaining Rs 15. Tata Steel also moved up to Rs. 1341 on speculative support, reacting thereafter on profit taking to close at Rs. 1310 with a small gain of Rs.10. Century, from Rs. 6110, rose sharply to Rs. 6125 on fresh support before setting at Rs. 6118. In kerb deal, trading activity was negligible and remained restricted to some deals in Tata Motors. The cash section too, displayed a positive outlook.
